


We had a visit from a Ranger who showed us some different animals and plants that can be found in the Phillip Island area and our area.

We looked at some ways these animals are being mistreated and how we can help.


We then walked around the school looking at some of the birds and plants in our school.

Homework tips for success




Setting limits

This Term, our Preppies, Year ones and Year twos are cooking up a storm with Brenda, making Pizza Muffins! Sounds like a great recipe to do on a Saturday night with the kids, thanks Brenda!


PIZZA MUFFINS

Ingredients

3 cups self-raising flour
1 ½ cups tasty cheese
2/3 cups chopped pineapple
2 tablespoons tomato paste
1 cup milk
Small bunch of thyme and parsley
1 teaspoon baking powder
150g ham, chopped
2/3 cup vegetable oil
2 eggs
2 spring onions
Salt and pepper

Method

- ◆ Preheat oven to 180°. Turn on fan.
- ◆ Sift the flour and the baking powder into the large mixing bowl.
- ◆ Add to the flour, one cup of the tasty cheese.
- ◆ Add the chopped ham and the pineapple pieces. Stir to combine. Add salt and pepper to season.
- ◆ Wash and finely chop the thyme and parsley. Add to flour mix.
- ◆ Wash, top and tail, and finely chop the spring onions. Add to large bowl and stir ingredients together.
- ◆ In the small mixing bowl, add the oil, tomato paste, eggs and milk. Whisk to combine.
- ◆ Add the egg mixture to the flour mixture and stir through until just combined. (Do not over mix muffins, they will be tough!)
- ◆ Spoon the mixture into well greased muffin pans and sprinkle with remaining cheese.
- ◆ Bake for 30 minutes, or until cooked when tested with a skewer.
- ◆ Place muffins on cooling rack.
- ◆ Arrange muffins on 4 serving plates and garnish with parsley.

We are currently looking for donations of Lego. We don't require any sets, we are looking for any loose pieces that you aren't using anymore for our STEM challenge. Thank you!




